1.25 MILLION PEOPLE DIE EACH YEAR ON THE WORLD'S ROADS AND 20 TO 50 MILLION SUSTAIN NON-FATAL INJURIES¹



ROAD TRAFFIC INJURIES ARE THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE, AGED 15-29 YEARS²



ROAD CRASHES ARE RISING TO THE **7th LEADING** CAUSE OF DEATH BY 2030 AND ALREADY COST THE WORLD **USD \$518 billion** PER YEAR.³



ROUGHLY 90%

OF ROAD ACCIDENTS OCCUR IN LOW AND MIDDLE INCOME COUNTRIES, DESPITE ONLY HAVING ROUGHLY HALF OF THE WORLD'S REGISTERED VEHICLES⁴



Males represent nearly three-quarters of those killed on the road today; while persons aged 15 to 44 represent 59% of road fatalities⁵

VULNERABLE ROAD USERS

(pedestrians, cyclists, and riders of motorized two-wheelers and their passengers) represent

49% OF ROAD TRAFFIC DEATHS AROUND THE WORLD⁶



The risk to this group of road users is even more pronounced in lower income countries
